The emphasis will be on discussion rather than formal presentations and the audience is seen as an integral part of each panel. The sessions will be divided into "language groupings" to facilitate the simultanious translation in english, french and german made available by the Forum.

For the third successful year the AUFSTAND is promoting 60 films in the festival and the Maket. AUF provides the visibility that prevents Independent Cinema from beeing marginalized in this busy and crowded market place and focusses the attention of potential buyers/critics/theorists on important developments in the international scene.
